## Help For Heroes

Help for Heroes (H4H) was founded by Bryn and Emma Parry after a profoundly moving visit to Selly Oak Hospital in the summer of 2007. Bryn and Emma met some extraordinarily brave young people who had been badly wounded and they just wanted to do something to help. The charity was then launched in October 2007 and, with the backing and support of celebrities, the Royal Family, the media and countless ordinary decent people, it has raised over £1m a month since then. Help for Heroes is strictly non-political. The money that is raised at Help for Heroes is used to support wounded servicemen and women of every colour and creed.

The message is simple: H4H does not seek to criticise or be political, it simply wants to help and does so by asking everyone to do their bit to raise money. Once the money is raised, H4H go to the experts in the Army, Royal Navy and Royal Air Force for guidance as to how best to spend it. It is the intention to spend all that is raised on the practical, direct support of those wounded in the service of our country since 9/11.

At Boughton, follow left hand fork and, just before canal bridge, turn right into Filkins Lane and then immediately left into Boughton hall Ave. Ground is in front of you.

Follow road for a further 5 miles and at fourth set of traffic lights, immediately after shell garage and Hinderton Arms Hotel, turn left into Hinderton Rd (B5134). After one mile turn right at T-Junction and traffic lights. After a further 100 yards turn left at Neston Cross, continue down Parkgate Rd and ground is half a mile on the left.

From the University, turn right onto Parkgate Rd. At roundabout turn left onto Inner Ring Road, pass Northgate Arena on your left. At next roundabout turn left onto A56 signed Motorway M53/M56 and follow for two miles. At Junction 15 follow slip road under both motorways to join M56 Eastbound signed Manchester. Leave M56 at next junction, 14, and turn right onto A5117 signed Hapsford/Helsby. Follow through traffic lights with Helsby Arms on the left and then turn right signed Alvanley. Follow road to T-junction, then turn right. After 400 yards turn left at next T-junction, through village and ground is 600 yards on the right after the Arden Lea housing estate.

## **Information for Managers and Parents**

### **Arrival:**

All players and officials should arrive at Chester University between 2 pm and 5 pm on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2010. Any known late arrivals should be notified to the Festival Director in advance. Registration will take place in the Binks Building where there will also be an information desk, manned by "Visit Chester and Cheshire", to provide details of local attractions, maps, accommodation in the city etc.

### **Accommodation:**

Squads will be accommodated in Fisher and Astbury Houses. Please advise boys that individual rooms will be lockable. Festival officials and ESCA personnel will be accommodated in Hollybank House. One towel will be provided, so bring more if needed.

Breakfast and evening meals will be provided in the Dining Hall. Cricket lunches will be served on the grounds where matches are being played. Evening meetings, Buffet Supper and Charity Auction and every social event on the site will be held in the Small Hall.

N.B. The Binks Building is open all day for snacks meals and refreshments etc. Mon to Fri.

### **Regional Squads:**

Regional Squads will consist of a maximum of 14 players plus one manager and two coaches.

### **Code of Conduct:**

The Festival will operate under the Code of Conduct-ESCA/ECB Activities enclosed in parents' pack.
